

Students and families at Cherry Park were surveyed in December 2021 about their perceptions of their school in terms of Engagement, Academic Challenge, Instructional Methods, Culture, Belonging, and Relationships. In addition, students provided feedback about School Safety and Emotional and Mental Health.

We heard from 102% of students and 64% of families.

With the help of the nonprofit YouthTruth, we analyzed their responses to use for decision-making and improvements. Here are a few things we learned from the survey:



96% of families said "My school creates a friendly environment."



The percent of students who believe that their teachers want them to work their hardest.



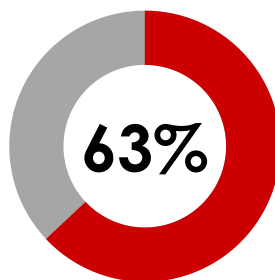
The amount of families who believe their teacher clearly communicates expectations for their child's progress. The national average is 75%.

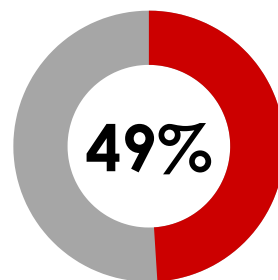
