Attend class daily.

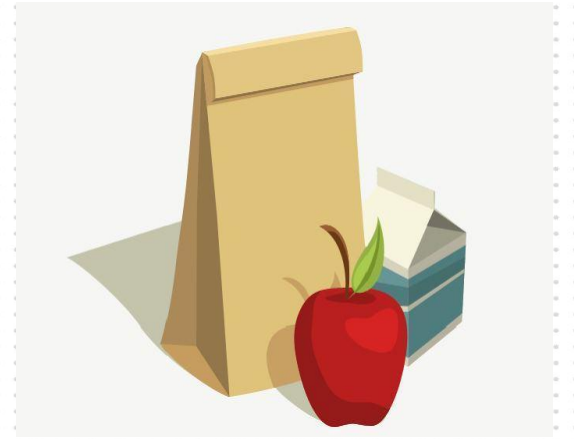
Participate in lessons.
