What will we learn?

- ✘ Develop rote and 1:1 counting skills.
- ✘ Learn correct pencil grip and how to use scissors.

Early Literacy Skills:



- Phonological awareness
 - Breaking words into sounds, pre-reading skills
 - Rhyming
- Print and alphabet knowledge
 - Naming and producing letter names and sounds
- Comprehension and text structure
 - Asking and answering questions about books
 - Understanding story structure
- Writing
 - Building fine motor skills
 - Writing for purpose
 - Writing letters and simple words, including own name



Early Math Skills

- Counting and number sense
- Sorting
- Shape recognition
- Simple patterns
